4. FIRST AID MEASURES

SKIN: Immediately flush skin with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes while removing contaminated clothing and footwear. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Discard footwear that cannot be decontaminated. If irritation persists, SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION IMMEDIATELY.

ENGINEERING CONTROLS: Good general ventilation (typically 10 air changes per hour) should be used. Ventilation rates should be matched to conditions. If exposure limits have not been established, maintain airborne levels to an acceptable level. Eye wash facilities and emergency shower must be available when handling this product.

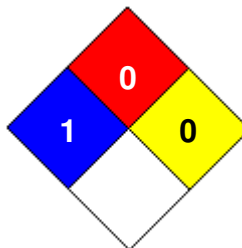
